Bare Spot Repair

Project Steps:

1 Loosen the Soil

Rake the soil to give your new grass a place to grow. For 50% thicker results, apply Turf Builder® Seeding Soil, over the area about one inch thick.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

Scotts® Turf Builder® Seeding Soil

Rake

Sprinkler

Hose

2 Apply Seed

Apply high quality Scotts® Turf Builder® Grass Seed with Water Smart and gently rake about ¼" of soil over the seeds.

3 Water

Water is essential for thick, fast germination. Water enough to keep the top layer of soil moist. When the seeds sprout and the grass matures, you can resume normal watering.
